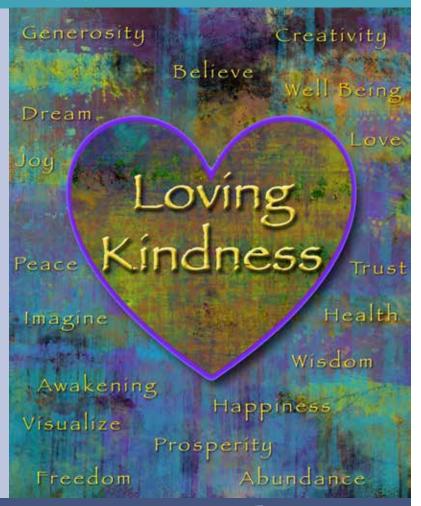

Through this practice the quality of patience, compassion, and equanimity are cultivated. Practicing loving kindness opens our hearts and minds.

"May I have mental happiness"; "May I have physical happiness"; "May I have ease of well-being."

"Just as I wish to be filled with loving kindness, so may you be filled with loving kindness. May you be happy, peaceful, and free from all suffering."

Our Monthly Newsletter Theme For February



Loving Kindness

February is the month of love, and Valentine's Day is the day we celebrate all forms of love: love for our significant other, for our family, friends and animal companions. So this month's theme is centered around Love.

Loving kindness is a state of mind that can be cultivated in each of us. If our thoughts help determine our reality, then when we cultivate loving kindness, we increase our sense of well-being and joy.

Meditation is about training the mind and heart to live in a way that allows us to be truly happy with our life as it is right now.

The practice of loving kindness meditation can lead to shifts in people's daily experiences of a wide range of positive emotions, including love, joy, gratitude, contentment, hope, pride, interest, amusement and awe. Loving kindness meditation has been shown to increase social connectedness, consciousness and social action.

Anyone can practice loving kindness meditation by sitting quietly and contemplating thoughts of kindness. Start with sending thoughts of loving kindness to yourself, using simple phrases such as: "May I be peaceful. May I be joyful. May I be happy. May I be free from suffering. May I have mental happiness. May I have physical happiness. May I have ease of well-being." You can add your own phrases.

Then turn your thoughts to a benefactor who you feel deep gratitude, and say, "Just as I wish to be filled with loving kindness, so may you be filled with loving kindness." And continue sending them blessing using the phrases above, "May you be...." etc. Next, turn your thoughts to a beloved friend or family member and continue with your thoughts of loving kindness. Afterward, turn your attention to a neutral person and send them blessings. Finally, turn your thoughts to a difficult person, sending them thoughts of loving kindness. This simple meditation practice can be done daily. (For more detailed instructions on Loving Kindness Meditation, visit TheJourneyWithin.info)

It is easier to send thoughts of loving kindness to people we care for, and much harder to do for difficult people in our lives. But when we realize that any unskillful action comes from greed, ignorance, or fear, we can neutralize our feelings for difficult people and open up our hearts to become more compassionate. Cultivating loving kindness is a lifetime practice, which is why it is called loving kindness meditation *PRACTICE*, as you are provided with a lifetime of opportunities ... well, too, practice!

Loving Kindness

Welcome to February, a month in which we have the opportunity - thanks to Valentine's Day! - to share with those in our lives our love and appreciation of them. And if you haven't one already, this is a wonderful month to create a practice of Loving kindness.

Loving kindness, a practice found in various religious and spiritual traditions, is defined as tenderness and consideration toward others, and ourselves. Sharon Salzburg, author of the book "Lovingkindness", writes that the first step of the Buddhist practice of Loving kindness, or Metta, begins by directing your attention toward yourself:

Can you wish for yourself, and receive, the intention to be happy and peaceful? When we take time to truly love and care for our selves, we are then able to perceive the goodness in others, to see that just like us, they want to be happy. And if we can't see the goodness in ourselves or others, your intention is enough. Try reflecting on the idea that underneath our thoughts, words and actions, all of us wish to be happy.

A practice of Loving kindness doesn't mean we ignore difficult qualities or less than skillful actions in either ourselves or others. Rather, it allows us to acknowledge these difficulties, while at the same time choosing to focus on the positive. When we focus on the positive, we form a connection with that person, affirm their right to be happy, and demonstrate our support.

Here is a beautiful, simple, four-step Loving kindness practice offered by the Dalai Lama:

- 1. At the beginning of each day, remember we all want the same things: To be happy, loved, connected.
- 2. Cherish yourself and others, letting go of judgments.
- 3. During the day, extend that attitude to everyone you meet.
- 4. Stay in the practice, no matter what happens!

This month, try choosing to consciously see the goodness in yourself, extend your Loving kindness to others, then notice what happens.

May you be well, may you be happy, may you be at peace, may you be at ease, may you be healthy.

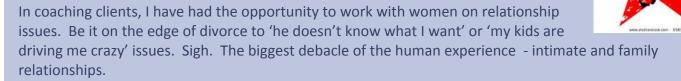

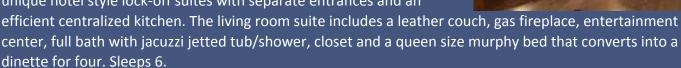

's Dog Treats



Method:

- 1. Preheat oven to 350° F.
- 2. Mix dry ingredients in a bowl. In a smaller bowl mash the banana & cooked yams, add in olive oil & chicken broth. Mix all ingredients until thoroughly combined, kneading with hands. Add more liquid if needed. Divide into 4 balls.
- 3. Roll out dough ball between parchment paper, 1/8" consistent thickness in rectangular shape to fit baking sheet. Discard top parchment paper, use for next baking tray. Transfer rectangular shaped dough with the bottom parchment paper to baking sheet. Use pizza cuter to cut dog treats in 1" checkerboard pattern. Use a ruler to help cut straight lines.
- 4. Bake 25-30 minutes slightly brown, not burnt. The crisps should will be chewier than other crisps. If you prefer a softer treat, bake for 15-20 minutes. Remove from oven and cool.

This recipe uses 4 baking sheet/trays.

These treats are a soft thin treat & are very tasty. Recipe makes enough treats to fill a little more than 1.6 quart storage container with some to share with dog friends & keep in tins around the house. You can keep the dog treat crisps 2 weeks at room temperature in an airtight container or in the refrigerator 4 weeks.

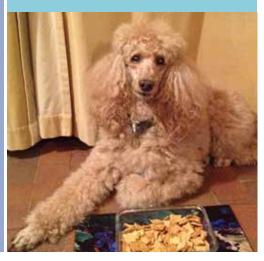

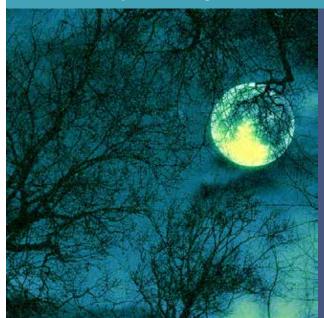
