

## Emergence

The term "emergence" comes from the Latin verb *emerge*, which means to arise, to rise up, to come up or to come forth.

Emergence is the way complex systems and patterns arise out of a multiplicity of relatively simple interactions. Emergence has to do with relationships: the relationships among the parts, or the relationship of the system to its environment. Parts of a system that are related are also often referred to as a network or an ecosystem.

### Emergence



Emergence has to do with relationships: the relationships among the parts, or the relationship of the system to its environment. Parts of a system that are related are also often referred to as a network or an ecosystem.

I love what Margret Wheatley and Deborah Frieze wrote in their article: "Using Emergence To Take Social Innovations To Scale."

"In spite of current ads and slogans, the world doesn't change one person at a time. It changes as networks of relationships form among people who

discover they share a common cause and vision of what's possible. This is good news for those of us intent on changing the world and creating a positive future. Rather than worry about critical mass, our work is to foster critical connections. We don't need to convince large numbers of people to change; instead, we need to connect with kindred spirits. Through these relationships, we will develop the new knowledge, practices, courage, and commitment that lead to broad-based change."

Emergence only happens through connections. "Act locally, connect regionally, learn globally."

It is not our task to change the entire world all at once, but of reaching out to mend the part of the world that is within our sphere. What works best is the accumulation of acts, stepping forward, lending a helping hand and doing it over and over, like rain drops in a bucket until it spills over.

The term "spiritual emergence" has been used to refer to the awakening of the spiritual potential within an individual that initiates the unfolding and expansion of that individual's way of being. It is a natural process of growth toward a deeper, more connected and expanded way of being, that usually occurs slowly throughout our lives until it is gently integrated. When this process occurs rapidly or becomes very intense, it can seem disruptive and out of context with everyday life, precipitating a personal crisis which is referred to as a "spiritual emergency".

So when we look around our sphere of influence, we should ask of ourselves, "where can we best serve with our talents and our abilities to help make our community a better place and thus best contribute to the well-being of all living things."

### El Rincon via the Piedra Lisa Trail.

We can meet at **the Range** on Wyoming and Montgomery for breakfast at 9am and caravan up to the trail head.

This hike is on the front side of the Sandias. I was about 14 years old the first time I hiked it.

#### From Great Outdoors.com:

What makes it special: Piedra Lisa (Spanish for "smooth rock") offers views of some of the Sandias' most spectacular granite formations, including the massive wall known as the Shield. It's not difficult, and can usually be hiked in the winter.

Length: 4 miles

**Hiking time:** 2 to 4.5 hours **Difficulty:** Easy to moderate

Elevation gain: 6,920 to 8,200 feet

**Season:** Spring through fall

**Directions:** From Tramway Boulevard (an exit on both I-40 and I-25), head east on the Juan Tabo road near the north end of the range. The paved road ends at a dirt road. Take the dirt road to a parking lot, then walk past the gate a short distance to the trail head on the right.

**Notes:** Rincon is Spanish for "corner," and this trail leads to the point at which a small front ridge connects to the main bulk of the mountains. The trail continues after cresting the obvious ridge at the 2-mile mark, but the owner of a plot that straddles the trail a little farther ahead has prohibited travel through the area. During certain times of the year, a faint spur trail is open that leads east along the ridge of the Rincon for about half a mile.

### Feng Shui Spring Clearing

Q: This unusually warm weather makes me feel like I'm ready to emerge my winter cocoon. There's been a lot of sickness in my home this winter, is there anything I should do around my house to make sure we have a healthy spring?

**A:** One thing you can do is a thorough spring cleaning of your pantry and cabinets where you store food. In Feng Shui, a clean, food-filled pantry represents the center of family life and a symbol of good health and continuing prosperity. Here are four simple steps to Feng Shui your pantry as you emerge into the new season:

- 1. Remove all cleaning products, including the brooms, mops, buckets, and vacuum cleaner, from the pantry, shelves, or cabinets where you store food. In Feng Shui, when cleaning products and food are stored together it symbolizes cleaning away your good health. Keep your cleaning products these under the sink, in the laundry room, or in a separate closet. And it's important to avoid storing the trash or cat liter in the pantry.
- 2. Remove everything from your pantry, wipe the shelves, and get rid of anything that is expired. Replace old spices, nuts, and oils, and refill canisters with new flour and sugar.
- 3. Clear out your refrigerator. Don't just clean out the interior of the fridge, also be sure to pay attention to the exterior by updating old photos and children's drawings, removing forgotten shopping lists, and replacing the old take-out menus you have on the fridge door.
- 4. Sweep the pantry and kitchen floor to symbolically make room for good energy. Be sure to sweep out of the room toward the kitchen door instead of into the room. In Feng Shui terms, sweeping outward represents moving out old energy to make room for the new.

## Feng Shui Tip for March:

As the weather starts to change, transform your wardrobe by letting go of the clothes you no longer need, such as shoes that cause blisters, pants that ride a bit too high in the crotch, or the clothes that are a size too small. If you haven't worn an item of clothing for a year, remove it from your closet and donate it to charity. When you hold on to things that don't fit, you hold on to old energy and symbolically hold on to excess weight.

Spring is beginning to stir, change is in the air! I'm itching to throw off my heavy winter clothing and...well, I don't know what, yet! I can feel something inside of me wanting to emerge after cocooning all winter, now I just have to identify

what "it" is. Sometimes the hardest part of allowing something new to emerge is discovering what wants to sprout, or uncovering what in your life needs to be weeded out.

When I find myself wanting to change or grow but uncertain as to what or how, I plan a change garden, following these easy steps to help me uncover what's ready to emerge:

#### 1. Clear

Just like a seed ready to sprout, what wants to emerge from you needs space in order to crack through the shell of your busy daily life. Give yourself permission to clear some time to explore, to dream – to plan your garden.

#### 2. Prepare the Soil

If you want your seeds to grow into healthy plants, you have to prepare the soil: break up the big chunks, add soil amenders, toss away the rocks. Break up your chunks of life by taking a look at your daily activities: Brushing your teeth...pulling together the numbers for the budget meeting... going to yoga...making your sales calls...preparing dinner. At the end of your day, make a quick list of your activities, review each one and note if it's something that lit you up, or felt like a clod of dirt.

#### 3. Choose your Seeds

As you look over your activities and reactions, you'll notice patterns emerging, likes and dislikes. What appeals? What makes you cringe? If an activity feels like a lump of dirt, perhaps it's time to let it go. If an activity brings you a warm feeling, it's a seed, wanting to sprout and reach for the sun. #### 4. Plant




### What's New in Design: 4 Secrets of Home Staging

#### 3. Room Transformations







# 's Dog Treats



#### Method:

- 1. Preheat oven to 350° F.
- 2. Mix dry ingredients in a large bowl. Mix all ingredients until thoroughly combined, kneading with hands. Add more liquid if needed. Divide into 4 balls.
- 3. Roll out dough ball between parchment paper, 1/8" consistent thickness in rectangular shape to fit baking sheet. Discard top parchment paper, use for next baking tray. Transfer rectangular shaped dough with the bottom parchment paper to baking sheet. Use pizza cuter to cut dog treats in 1" checkerboard pattern. Use a ruler to help cut straight lines.
- 4. Bake 30-40 minutes slightly brown, not burnt. If you prefer a softer treat, bake for 15-20 minutes. Remove from oven and cool. This recipe uses 4 baking sheet/trays.

These treats are a soft thin treat & are very tasty. Recipe makes enough treats to fill a little more than 1.6 quart storage container with some to share with dog friends & keep in tins around the house. You can keep the dog treat crisps 2 weeks at room temperature in an airtight container or in the refrigerator 4 weeks.




