Lets hike a lower elevation canyon dominated by pinon-juniper and southern evergreen oaks. There are some Ponderosas and Beautiful views of the South Peak of the Sandias. Hiking is moderate to strenuous. Elevation is about 6,300 ft.

This is a world reknown trail for people who love to watch birds. Birders come from around the world to hike this trail! Click on the link above and rea all about the wonders in your own backyard!

Excellent for resident pinon-juniper birds such as Juniper Titmouse and Canyon Towhee and on the canyon sides one can find Rufous-crowned Sparrow and Scott's Orioles breed.

Imagination is overrated. Great for entertainment and inspiration---but then what? Most people associate Imagination with conjuring, dreaming, magic, escape. Christmas in July - Rates Stay Low

I write about the Federal Reserve Board often. There's a good reason for that: The Fed holds the key to mortgage interest rates. Every month when the Federal Open Market Committee (FOMC) meets, the financial world anxiously awaits the official comments and analyzes every word.

After strong indications that it would raise rates as early as June, the Fed pulled back recently, citing weakness in the U.S. labor market and economy in general. They said they'd review on a meeting-bymeeting basis, which leads analysts to think that the Fed won't raise rates until September, unless the economy puts on growth spurt.

What does this mean? We may have Christmas this Summer, with home loan rates staying low for purchases and refinances.

Let's take a look at what's happened in the past and what's projected for 2016.

Freddie Mac¹ reported that the 30 year fixed rate was 3.7 percent in April 2015. That's low! They project that it will rise to near 5 percent in 2016. How does this compare with historic mortgage rates? In the 1970s, the average rate was 8.86 percent. In the 1980s, it rocketed up to 12.7 percent. In the 1990s, it was 8.12 percent. And in the first decade of the 2000s, it was 6.29 percent.

If you're wondering about the all-time high and low, consider this: On November 21, 2012, the average 30 year fixed rate mortgage was 3.31 percent. On October 9, 1981, it was 18.63 percent. Those rates make a startling difference in monthly mortgage payments. For a \$200,000 loan, the approximate monthly payment (principal and interest only) for the low rate would be \$877, and for the high rate, \$3,177. That's a difference of \$2,300 a month. The numbers speak for themselves.

These low rates may encourage you to start looking for a home. Don't wait. Inventory has been very low over the last few months and in April (the most recent figures available), the National Association of Realtors reported that year-over-year inventory was down by almost 1 percent. Low inventory tends to drive prices up, favoring sellers, and low rates mean there will probably be more competition, too. Talk to your Realtor about homes, and be sure to get pre-qualified with your lender so your offer will be stronger.

Still wondering if buying a home is a good idea?

Let me share some insights from John Paulson, the billionaire money manager who foresaw the collapse of the real estate market and made a fortune from it. At a conference last year, he made it clear that he believes homeownership is a great investment.³ He pointed out that financing costs are extraordinarily low, and if you put 10 percent down and the home value increases by 5 percent, you've made a 50 percent return on your investment.

's Dog Treats



Method:

- 1. Preheat oven to 350° F.
- 2. Mix the wet ingredients: banana, grated carrots, grated cheddar cheese, chicken broth, apple cider vinegar & coconut oil in a bowl.
- 3. Mix dry ingredients in a large bowl: rice flour, flax seed meal, wheat germ, rolled oats, flax seeds & cinnamon. Combine all the ingredients. Divide into 4 balls.
- 4. Roll out dough ball between parchment paper, 1/8" consistent thickness in rectangular shape to fit baking sheet. Discard top parchment paper, use for next baking tray. Transfer rectangular shaped dough with the bottom parchment paper to baking sheet. Use pizza cuter to cut dough in parallel strips to create a checkerboard of 1" squares. Use a ruler to help cut straight lines.
- 5. Bake 30-35 minutes slightly brown. If you prefer a softer treat, bake for 20-25 minutes. Remove from oven and cool. This recipe uses 4 baking sheet/trays.

These treats are soft & are very tasty. Recipe makes enough treats to fill a little more than 3 quart storage container with some to share with dog friends & keep in tins around the house. You can keep the dog treat crisps up to 1 week at room temperature in an airtight container or in an airtight container in the refrigerator up to 4 weeks.

Banana Carrot Cheese Treats

Ingredients:

- 2 ripe bananas
- 4 grated carrots, 2 cups
- 1 cup of grated cheddar cheese
- 2 cups rice flour (or any flour)
- 1 cup rolled oats, uncooked
- 1 cup flax seed meal
- ½ cup wheat germ
- 1 cup flax seeds
- 1 ½ cup chicken broth
- 1.5 tablespoons apple cider vinegar
- ½ cup coconut oil
- 1 tablespoon cinnamon

*Parchment paper for rolling out the dough, pizza cutter, ruler for cutting straight lines & a dog to snoopervise.
