

This scenic route from Chimayo to Vadito takes you to galleries and studios of artisans along the High Road between Santa Fe and Taos with more than 60 stops.



Creating Clarity Awareness

My client stared at me, dumbfounded. After sharing her feelings of frustration with her life and how others had priority, I had asked: "What do *you* want?" Realization was dawning that in the midst of commitments to work and family, her awareness of her values, needs, and dreams had slipped away.

Awareness - consciousness - is like a spotlight illuminating objects. Over the course of a day, and a lifetime, we shine our spotlight in many different directions. As we constantly juggle the demands of life and meeting the expectations and needs of others, it's easy to lose sight of our own well being and functioning. When we don't include ourselves in the spotlight of our awareness, our values, desires, feelings and needs may go unmet, oftentimes leaving us experiencing numbness, dissatisfaction, even sadness.

We all want to enjoy our lives and feel fulfilled, and cultivating self-awareness helps us get there. When you increase your awareness, your spotlight shines on what has value and meaning for you. Self-awareness nurtures clarity of purpose, enabling you to grow courage to support what's important to you and make decisions are made more easily. You strengthen your abilities to transform your values and goals into meaningful words and actions.

You can begin cultivating self-awareness in two steps: Tune In and Turn On:

Tune In

Get Physical Begin by tuning in to your physical senses. What's the temperature of the room you're in? How hard or soft is your chair? How full or empty does your stomach feel? Your body is amazingly aware of what is occurring, both within and around you. Noticing your physical sensations in this moment develops your ability to focus, to become aware. Check in with your body a couple of times a day, or if you find yourself sitting at a stoplight.

Get Emotional Joy...Sadness...Anger...Silliness. As your physical awareness increases, begin to notice what responses your emotions illicit within you. You might put the spotlight on emotions arising as you're idling in rush-hour traffic; What effects do they have on your body?

Turn On

As you build your awareness of your physical sensations, thoughts and emotions, turn your spotlight onto your values. Ask yourself: What's important to me? What triggers a particular reaction? What behavior is intolerable? Who do I admire, and why? What do I want more of? Less of? Questions such as these will help you become more aware of what's important to you, your values.

I automatically stop to smell roses. You may do this too. Sometimes my mind gets in the way, starts wondering if I really have time to take a break. But mostly, I just stop to smell.

I feel the same way smelling the approach of an oncoming rain.

The magic happens too watching the beauty of a sunset. I can feel a snowflake melting on my hand.

I savor the taste of a juicy organic Colorado peach. I love to capture the sound of a laughing baby.

What are the smells, touches, sounds, tastes, and sights that make you stop, breathe, and enjoy? We all have special ones. In that brief moment, the world stops and awareness expands. We touch gratitude and find beauty in the moment.

It's important medicine. We knew how to do it as children, and, in the busyness of life can forget. Mainstream does not reward us for these breaks. Yet, it is not only important, but essential, medicine.

These are special moments. Respiration slows. We move

into appreciation and gratitude. Parts of the brain and the brain and the heart begin to work together. Life seems easier. Focus increases. We move toward empathy and compassion. Other senses open up. We smile and others smile. We have arrived at a new place. We experience more connection with life.

Research shows that awareness breaks, each invitation to the senses and/ or breath help brain cells find new connections, move our experience into - less fear and more trust; less isolation and more connection; less defensiveness and more openness to listen; less reaction and more choice.

What if we prioritized awareness moments during the day? An experiment at Google showed that a two-minute break of breath awareness improved productivity by 10%!

Charlotte Selver, a pioneer in exploring the transformation possible through sensory awareness, wrote, "Every moment is a moment. Every moment makes a certain request of us. The question is how we answer it."

Our senses help us find the moment, slow things down, to become aware of choices. The value is clear. "The question is how we answer it."

Stock market is key to million dollar plus housing market

We've seen a shift in the sales of properties in the \$1 million plus range, and if you're thinking of buying, now may be a good time.

What drives the high-end home market? An interesting study¹ confirmed a common-sense assumption: When the market goes up, sales of \$1 million plus homes follow. The study tracked the stock market from 2009 to a peak in 2015 and correlated high-end home sales with that growth. The result shows that while sales of homes priced at \$1 million or more historically hovered around 1.2 percent of the market, by the time stocks hit their May 2015 high, those sales nearly doubled to 2.2 percent of the market.

What's happened since confirms these findings. In June of this year, the National Association of Realtors reported that sales of homes priced at \$1 million or more had reached 2.7 percent of the market nationally. That's an increase of 150 percent over the historic market share! In Santa Fe, the statistics are equally impressive. The most recent data I gathered from the Santa Fe Association of Realtors shows that sales of single family homes in Santa Fe (City and County) of \$1 million or more increased about 116 percent in July 2016 compared to July 2015. At the same time, the stock market broke through to a new high.

Another development that has influenced home sales recently is the Brexit vote earlier this summer – the decision by voters in the UK to leave the European Union. The Brexit vote initially sent shockwaves through the financial markets that led to lower home loan interest rates. (Mortgage rates are tied to US Treasury notes, and as investors left the stock markets, they moved their funds to these less-volatile investments, leading to lower interest rates.) The markets have recovered, but interest rates have stayed low – for now.

I've been watching recent comments from members of Federal Reserve Board of Governors, and I'm hearing sentiment in favor of a rate increase this year. New York Fed President William Dudley was quoted in mid-August³ as saying that the labor market is getting tighter and there are signs of wage gains starting to accelerate, so "we're getting closer to that point in time when it will be appropriate to actually raise short-term rates again." A stronger statement came earlier in the month from San Francisco Fed President John Williams⁴ who was asked directly if the Fed's move to gradual rate increases should include a rate hike this year, and he said, "In my view, it does."

Remember last December when Fed Chair Janet Yellen led the decision to raise interest rates by ¼ percent? The Dow was trading below 16,000 in September, followed by an increase to about 17,800 in November. The rate hike took place on December 16th. Stocks rallied briefly, but they fell steadily in January, ending below 16,000 in February and thereby losing all the gains from the December rate hike. Now we have seen record closes over 18,500 in July and August.⁵ With a rate hike in the offing and the uncertainty that comes in an election year, this may be a volatile time for stocks.

Will mortgage interest rates rise from their current 2 year lows? Will the stock market fall from its record highs? I can't find consensus among the analysts, but if you are in the market for a luxury property, this may be the best time to buy.

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

Highlights:

- the median detached home price rose 3.2 percent to \$189,900
- the average detached price rose 6.8 percent to \$226,192
- the number of new listings decreased 3.3 percent for single-family detached homes and 24.4 percent for condos, townhomes and other attached homes
- inventory of detached home for sale dropped 16.1 percent in July
- detached homes sold in an average of 48 days which is 20% faster than in July 2015
- the 1,060 homes sold in July 2016 remained stable with a negligible 0.2 percent increase
- pending sales increased 7.9 percent for detached homes

Method:

- 1. Preheat oven to 350° F.
- 2. Place the wet ingredients, zucchini & pumpkin in a bowl. Stir until thoroughly combined. Place the dry ingredients in a bowl & mix. Combine wet & dry ingredients. Add water as needed to combine the ingredients. Divide into 4 balls.
- 3. Roll out dough ball between parchment paper to 1/8" -1/16" thickness in rectangular shape to fit baking sheet. Discard top parchment paper. Transfer rectangular dough with the bottom parchment paper to baking sheet. Use pizza cuter to cut dough in parallel strips to create a checkerboard of 1" squares. Use a ruler to help cut straight lines.
- 4. Bake 45-50 minutes until no longer moist. Remove from oven and place upside down to remove parchment paper while hot.

"The parchment paper makes the rolling easy, with no mess & cutting the crisps with the pizza cutter is super fast. You can keep them up to 1 week at room temperature in an airtight container or in the refrigerator for up to 4 weeks. You can also freeze them! I love these crisps because they are thin & I get to eat more. More is always better than less. After all, more is more!!!!" ~ Aeowyn


Zucchini Pumpkin Oatmeal Treats
